#R2006-211 SCHEDULE PUBLIC HEARING – PROPOSED LOCAL LAW – TOWN OF WARWICK TRANSFER TAX

Motion Supervisor Sweeton, seconded Councilman DeAngelo to adopt a resolution to schedule a Public Hearing on August 17, 2006, at the Town Hall, 132 Kings Highway, Warwick, NY 10990 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, for the purpose of considering a local law to establish a Town of Warwick Transfer Tax of three quarters of one percent on real estate sales in the Town of Warwick. The local law will exempt certain transactions and certain amounts from the imposition of the tax. The authority for such local law is pursuant to Section 64-g of the New York Town Law and Article 31-F of the New York Tax Law, which legislation is commonly known collectively as the Warwick Community Preservation Act.
