Supervisor Sweeton – This is an annual requirement from the New York State DEC. We are required to file an MS4 annual report and the area that’s an MS4 area for the town is the area around and surrounding Greenwood Lake. It is a series of measures that deal with monitoring of discharges that could potentially enter the lake and also educational things that we do. We work with the Groundwater Guardian Program and we do obviously through our Building Department enforcement on issues of illegal discharges. The report documents all of that and it is online on the townofwarwick.org and it’s in the clerks office. This is a hearing on that report and I will open it to the floor for any comments.
