

This letter is to advise you that the request for speed reduction on a portion of Jessup Road in the Town of Warwick has been approved.

We have completed our review of the 40 MPH speed limit zone on Jessup Road between Pine Island Turnpike (CR1) and Sargent Road. Our study included field reviews of the geometry and conditions on Jessup Road.

Based on our study, we find it appropriate to reduce the linear speed limit on Jessup Road to 30 MPH from Sargent Road to CR1 a distance of 2.8 miles. Please see the attached Traffic Regulation – 1133.37 (bc).



INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW
AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WARWICK

A Local Law amending Chapter 104, entitled “Outdoor Furnaces”, of the Code of the Town of Warwick, as more fully set forth below:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Warwick, Orange County, New York, as follows:

Section 1 –TOWN CODE AMENDED:

The Town of Warwick Town Code is hereby amended by amending Section 104-6. Specific Requirements to read as follows:

Section 104-6. Specific Requirements shall be amended to read as follows:

All Outdoor Wood furnaces installed in the Town of Warwick must, as a minimum, comply with NYS DEC 6NYCRR Part 247 except where the requirements of Chapter 104 are more stringent.

- A. Permitted fuel. Only seasoned, clean firewood, untreated lumber and wood pellets made from clean wood are permitted to be burned in any outdoor furnace. Burning of any and all other materials in an outdoor furnace is prohibited.
- B. Permitted zones. Outdoor furnaces shall be permitted only in the RU, MT, CO, and AI zoning districts as shown on the Town’s Zoning Map.
- C. Minimum lot size. Outdoor furnaces shall be permitted only on lots of three acres or more.
- D. Setbacks. Outdoor furnaces shall be set back not less than 200 feet from the nearest adjoining or neighboring dwelling. Further, in any event the furnace shall be located a minimum of 150 feet from the adjoining property line.
- E. Months of operation. Outdoor furnaces shall be operated only between September 1 and May 31.
- F. All outdoor furnaces must be equipped with a permanent stack extending a minimum of 18 feet above the ground level. The Town of Warwick may require that the permanent stack extend up to two (2) feet above the peak of any roof structure within 150 feet of the outdoor furnace when necessary to avoid or resolve nuisance conditions.

Section 2. – This Local Law will take effect upon the filing of same with the New York State Secretary of State.

Dear Members of the Warwick Town Board,

During the 12 years I served on the Warwick Town Board (1990 through 2001) and the 12 years since then (2002 through 2013), six plaques were installed in the lobby of the Warwick Town Hall to commemorate those citizens of Warwick who served in our nation's following wars.

- Revolutionary War
- World War I
- World War II
- Korean War
- Vietnam War
- Persian Gulf War

An obvious oversight is a plaque to commemorate those who served in the Union's cause during the U.S. Civil War. I consider this nonfeasance on my part.

Company D (The Warwick Boys) was part of the 124th Regiment of the New York State Volunteers (The Orange Blossoms). Books by Weygant and by LaRocca, and the mustering roster of Company D, are sufficient sources for compiling the list of names of Warwick's citizens that would appear on a U.S. Civil War plaque. I am in possession of all three of the above-mentioned sources.

I plan to have a U.S. Civil War plaque made, and ask that the Town install it in the Town Hall lobby. I will raise the funds for the plaque. Any financial help from the Town, although not required, would be much appreciated. I am available to provide any additional information pertaining to this matter.
