Dear Supervisor Sweeton and Town Board Members:

Enclosed are the 2012 tour sheets for the upcoming Country Roads Tour sponsored by the Orange County Bicycle Club. The routes are the same as in previous years. The event will begin and end at Warwick Valley High School on Sunday, September 16, 2012. I have also enclosed the requisite certificate of insurance naming the Town as an additional insured.

The Tour will be held rain or shine. Based upon last year's attendance we are planning for 800 +/- . The Orange County Bicycle Club will have over 120 volunteers at the site and out on the roads providing support services.

There are 4 different rides - 10, 21, 42 & 61 miles. The 10 and 21 mile routes are entirely in the town and the 42 and 61 routes travel through the town. The cue sheets provide a mile by mile recapitulation of the route.

Riders will be leaving the school beginning at 7:30 am for the longer rides, and all riders will be on the road by 11 am. The largest groups are usually the 21 to 42 mile groups, leaving the school from 9 to 10 am and returning for lunch between noon and 2 pm. All riders are finished by 3 pm.

We have each rider sign a waiver which informs the rider that roads are not closed and they must follow the traffic laws. We inform riders to "Share the Road", keep to the right, signal intentions, etc. We also have signs reading "Bike Route, Drive Safe". These red and white signs give motorists notice that there are cyclists on the roads and remind cyclists that they are sharing roads with motorists. These signs are put up a day before the event and removed by the next day.

Thank you for your continued support and cooperation in the Hudson Valley's largest and best bicycle event.

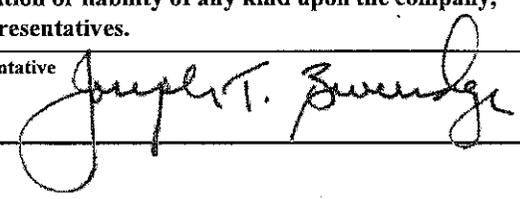

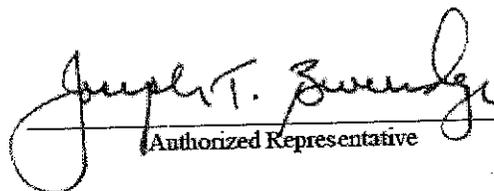

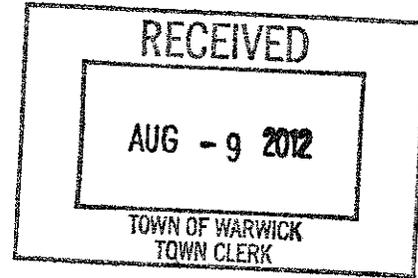

RE: United Water South County Sewer Rate Increase
Town Board Resolution Approving Rates, July 19, 2012

Dear Supervisor Sweeton:

As referenced during our telephone conversation, United Water South County Sewer (“United”) appreciates that the Town of Warwick acted promptly on its request to increase the rates it charges customers who use its sewer service systems within the Town of Warwick. However, the Resolution passed by the Town Board on July 19, 2012, approving an increase failed to recognize the Company’s voluntary agreement to (1) reduce the rate of return included in the rates approved, (2) defer part of the increase, and (3) spread the increase over a three-year period. These voluntary steps were made to address the concerns raised by the Towns of Warwick and Tuxedo and to minimize the burden on the customers.

Also, the Resolution includes incorrect claims that go beyond the Town’s statutory powers and implies agreement where there was none. These problems should be corrected.

In the eighth whereas clause, the Town states that United has made improvements to its wastewater system without compliance with Transportation Corporations Law (“TCL”) § 118. This is false. All of the improvements implemented by United comply with TCL § 118.

In paragraph 2 of the Town determinations, the Town directs the Company to file accurate financial statements with it by March 15 of each calendar year. The TCL does not contain any provision that allows it to unilaterally direct a sewage-works corporation to make continued filings as a contingency for future rate increases. There is nothing in the statute that allows the Town to assess penalties. And “for the Town Board to [predetermine a future rate penalty] now, without a full understanding of the particular circumstances . . . is an arbitrary and capricious exercise on the part of the Town Board” (*Heritage Hills Sewage Works Corporation v. Town Board of Town of Somers*, 54 A.D.3d 673, 675, 863 N.Y.S.2d 255, 256 (2nd Dept., 2008)). Furthermore, the denial of rate relief, as proposed in the Resolution, is contrary to the requirements of TCL § 121; case law, *Bennett Road Sewer Co. v. Town of Camillus*, 273 A.D.2d

902, 709 N.Y.S.2d 768 (4th Dept., 1998); and the Constitution of the United States, *Federal Power Commission v. Hope Natural Gas Co. City of Cleveland*, 320 U.S. 591, 603 (1944). The requirement to file and the threat to deny future rate relief is inconsistent with the facts and the law.

In paragraph 3 of the Town's determinations, the Town instructs United to comply with TCL § 118. The Company has complied with TCL § 118, and there is nothing in the record that can support this finding. Also, there is nothing in TCL § 118 that requires the Company to advise the Town of capital improvements either before or after they are made. Paragraph 3 further states failure to advise the Town of planned capital improvements and "permitting the Town to determine the proper costs for such improvements shall preclude the seeking a [sic] rate adjustments in relation thereto". The Town has no authority to make such a directive or to determine the proper costs of improvements. Further, the Town's attempt to adopt such authority without legislation conflicts with the State's authority in this area as exercised by the Department of Environmental Conservation and the Health Department. For the reasons stated above, the requirements and penalties set forth in paragraph 3 are inconsistent with the facts and the law.

Agreement between the Town and the Company is the essence of the rate setting provisions of the Transportation Corporations Law § 121. The Company did not agree to make the filings improperly mandated in the Resolution, paragraphs 2 and 3, or to accept the penalties threatened. However, United seeks to maintain its productive and cooperative relationship with the Town of Warwick. If the Town corrects the Resolution, the Company will agree to submit the financial statements requested on an annual basis and an annual capital budget. It will, also, discuss with the Town any questions it may have regarding the necessity or efficiency of planned improvements.

Both United and the Town seek to have the residents within the township provided with safe and adequate service at reasonable rates. United looks forward to a continued cooperative relationship with the Town of Warwick. Please let me know if you have any questions and how you would like to proceed.

As a Condition of Final Approval of the Mendrzycki Site Plan at 8 Rita Marie Lane, an Erosion Control Bond in the amount of \$5,600 was required because stabilization of the disturbed soils was not able to be achieved prior to the Planning Board Chairman signing the plans (due to cold weather condition). Mr. Mendrzycki posted this bond with check # 3228 and dated December 29, 2011. The Erosion Control Bond was formally accepted by the Town on January 06, 2012.

The requirement for the release of this bond is that the disturbed area must have achieved at least 80% stabilization of the area of disturbance; this is a NYSDEC requirement. At a site inspection on August 08, 2012, I determined that this property has achieved the minimum 80% stabilization required to release the bond.

At this time, I recommend that release of \$5,600; the entire amount of the Erosion Control Bond.
