



WARWICK VALLEY COMMUNITY CENTER REPAIR CAFE

Lamp on the fritz? Vacuum cleaner coughs, but doesn't inhale? Broken zipper on your favorite jeans? Toss it? No way. Bring your beloved, but broken, item to a Repair Café. There, "Repair Coaches," guys and gals with technical skills, make the repair while you watch or help. A lot of things get fixed, for free, which builds community and reduces the amount of trash that we pay to truck to a landfill.

What kinds of things get fixed? The most popular items are lamps and vacuum cleaners, beyond that everything from clothes, dolls, stuffed animals, and jewelry to mechanical and electronic items - bikes, shopping carts, laptops - to things made of wood. Tool and knife sharpening, too.

The idea was born in Amsterdam in 2009 and has since spread across the U.S. There are Repair Cafes in several mid-Hudson towns – Beacon, Gardiner, Kingston, New Paltz, Poughkeepsie, Rhinebeck, and Rosendale, www.repaircafehv.org. Now it's our turn. The Warwick Valley (Doc Fry) Community Center has agreed to host the event, BUT we need volunteer repair coaches.

Thank you for your recent visit with the Warwick Golden Seniors. The information that you shared with us was very informative and interesting.

As discussed, there is a very dangerous traffic situation which I would like to again bring to your attention on behalf of our members and your constituents. The speed limit on Kings Highway in front of the Town Hall is 50 mph. With the new resurfacing, vehicles are exceeding the already high speed limit. The Town Hall parking lot is a busy parking lot with constant entering and exiting of traffic. The traffic flow begs for some attention by the very nature of the vehicles. We have emergency vehicles, buses, senior citizens, employees, contractor vehicles and the public-at-large using this lot. The entrance/exit ramp is rather narrow. Often entering traffic has to stop on the highway when faced with exiting traffic. Additionally, the proper flow of traffic is not always followed and can also cause a bottle neck at the entrance.


We implore you to remedy this situation as soon as possible for the safety of all. Lowering the speed limit and widening the entrance may help.


Start /Finish next to driveway for Apple Ridge Orchards (formerly Jessup Rd Orchards)

at a cost set forth below, _____ and the Town hereby agree as follows:


1. The Town will provide police presence in the form of up to one police

within thirty (30) days.


b. In addition, a charge of \$20.00/hour for each car assigned shall be computed and billed to compensate for wear and tear, fuel, etc.

Award Recommendation:


Based on the information obtained Allied Excavating, Inc. appears to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. **Based on the information presented, HDR recommends that a**



On behalf of T-Mobile, ATC is writing to solicit your input concerning the following personal communications system (PCS) equipment installation: the Site is located on the rooftop of St. Anthony's Community Hospital, 15 Maple Avenue in the Village of Warwick, Town of Warwick, Orange County, New York. The proposed project includes the installation of six (6) new T-Mobile antennas on the existing building. The antennas will be installed at a top height of 94.0 feet and will be concealed behind a screened wall. The building parapet is at a top height of 89.0 feet and a chimney is at a top height of 95.8-feet. Associated equipment will be installed on a lower roof level on a steel platform, also to be concealed with a screened wall. All construction will take place on and within the Site building. There will be no ground disturbance.

ATC is currently soliciting local government and public input concerning the projects with regard to potential effects on Historic Properties. As the project involves wireless communications, which are regulated by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), it is being reviewed under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act for its impacts on historic resources. Therefore, we are preparing a Form 621 submission packet of the proposed project for review by the New York State Historic Preservation Office (NY SHPO).
