On behalf of the Village of Harriman Board of Trustees I would like to thank you and Rebecca Hanlon for the invaluable assistance you provided to the Village of Harriman.

On Thursday August 9, 2012 the Village of Harriman was made aware of an animal abandonment and neglect situation involving 1 dog and 11 cats.


