The Village of Warwick has begun preparing for its Sesquicentennial Celebration 1867 – 2017.

On August 10<sup>th</sup> through the 19<sup>th</sup> in 1967, the Village celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> birthday. The Centennial celebration lasted 10 days and included a Queen's Coronation Ball, square dancing at Grange Hall and Stanley Deming Park, Religious Heritage Day, Ladies Day, Youth Day, Commerce and Industry Day, Agricultural Day and Parade Day with fireworks. In addition, "The Warwick Story" was presented in Memorial Park on four nights.

The Village has held a number of meetings to discuss ideas for the 150<sup>th</sup> and we are reaching out to all local organizations for representatives to form a committee and to plan for the coming celebration.

This letter is response to your letter dated August 20, 2015 requesting a speed limit reduction from 40 mph to 30 mph on Big Island Road, a Town highway between Wheeler Road and County Route 1A in the Town of Warwick.

A formal speed study has been completed at this location. The study included a field review of the roadway geometry and physical conditions on Big Island Road and a review of the last available three year accident history.

The field review found that the predominant characteristics are not conducive to a maximum speed of 30 mph. A reduced speed limit would not reflect the actual operating conditions of the roadway and consequently not be adhered to by majority of motorists. The review of the accident history did not find any accident patterns.

As a result of this study, the NYSDOT has determined that conditions are not conducive to lower travelling speeds. Therefore, reducing the speed limit would not be appropriate on Big Island Road.



2015 IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN SOLAR ENERGY USES**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on Monday the 21st day of December, 2015, at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, a Public Hearing will be held before the Town Board of the Town of Goshen, New York, at Town Hall, located at 41 Webster Avenue, Goshen, New York, to consider Introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2015. The purpose of this Introductory Local Law is to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Goshen and to maintain the *status quo* as to certain solar energy uses, as the present zoning regulations in the Town do not adequately address these types of uses. The moratorium is for a period of six (6) months, allowing the Town Board to analyze and determine potential appropriate revisions and amendments to the Town of Goshen Zoning Code concerning these uses. The proposed law is available for public review in the Town Clerk's office during normal office hours.
