LEGAL NOTICE: The clerk read the legal notice, which was duly published in the Warwick Valley Dispatch on February 20, 2013.

Supervisor Sweeton – This local law is to meet the new requirements from the State of New York. What we are doing is pulling out, which has been done in many other sections of our code, the fee structure from the actual local law and moving it into the Schedule of Development Fees which can be changed by resolution as opposed to having a public hearing to change the local law every time you need to change the fee. We are changing the fee because the State of New York has instructed us to do so. We’re also going to make note that under the new state regulations a scrap metal processors permit will terminate on June 30th of each year as opposed to the calendar year. Those are the only changes that we are making to the junk dealers law. We do actually have a junk dealer in the Town of Warwick; Specht’s Salvaging down on Covered Bridge Road. I will open it for any public comment on those changes.

There were no public comments for or against this public hearing.
