LEGAL NOTICE: The Clerk read the legal notice, which was duly published in the in the Warwick Valley Dispatch on April 2, 2014. (Copy of this legal notice is printed at the end of these minutes.)

Supervisor Sweeton – For the Board and the publics information this will set up the parameters by which the town can accept credit cards for payments. We have an RFP out for a vendor to supply counter card reading units that will allow them to take cards at the counter in the Clerk’s Office, Receiver of Taxes, the Building Department and the Water and Sewer Department. There will also be a web based feature to it so that if you want to pay a fee online you will be able to do that through the towns website. The RFP’s are due back I think in another couple of weeks and then we will start to get those and see which one is the most user friendly and the most easy to integrate with our existing software. The fees associated with these will be added as a fee to the user and that will be paid by them and they will know that up front what the fee is so that people can choose to do it or not. We will still accept all the traditional methods that we normally do here at Town Hall.
