Supervisor Sweeton – We've had films and videos shot in the Town in the past and when they called we would say, oh yeah you can do that and we would put them in touch with the Police Department and everything usually goes OK, but we're getting more activity there and we thought we should have a formal policy. We did pilfer quite a bit of it from the Village of Greenwood Lake and we thank them for that, but we are adopting one and modified it somewhat to fit us and it's timely since we have a couple of productions; one in the works and one going to be shortly. That's what the purpose of this is and there's a fee that gets paid to the Town and if they use any Town services they compensate for those services, so it just formalizes that.
