



## **SUPERVISORS REPORT**

1. This goes hand and hand with the bus facility construction, the bus facility is being constructed under a federal transportation grant working with Orange County to create a regional bus depot here because we serve multiple communities in Orange County. Hopefully if we award those bids this evening it will start on or about July 11<sup>th</sup> and it will be in the vacant lot and spill over into the lot of the current recycling center. I want the public to be aware that the recycling center will be closing on July 11<sup>th</sup> temporarily until we can find a location that's suited to get it back into operation. Everyone in the Village of Warwick and the Town of Warwick are entitled to curbside pickup so if you're a resident who doesn't currently use curbside you can call my office and we will arrange to have a bin delivered to your home so that you will be able to do it from the curbside. We don't know yet when we will have the recycling center back in operation but it's going to be out for several months and we will keep everyone informed of that. As of July 11<sup>th</sup> the recycling center will be closing so the construction can begin on the new bus facility.

2. I would like the public to be aware that we will be holding a Citizens Preparedness Training Event here in this room on June 30<sup>th</sup> a Thursday evening at 7:00 pm. That is being presented by the New York State National Guard in conjunction with New York State Department of Homeland Security. It's going to be a training seminar from 7:00 p.m. and it's usually about two hours so until 9:00 p.m. and they will instruct citizens on how to be prepared in the event that we have those kind of catastrophic events like we had with the hurricanes and flooding. I'm really looking forward to that and I encourage residents to come out that evening and we look forward to a great presentation. It does encourage people to be prepared because we learned during those events you can be isolated at times for a week or more and you should know what you need to have on hand and how to
