**LEGAL NOTICE:** The Clerk read the legal notice, which was duly published in the Warwick Valley Dispatch on October 17, 2012. (Copy of this legal notice is printed at the end of these minutes.)

Supervisor Sweeton – Part of the legislation that created the 2% levy cap requires a municipality each year to pass a new local law if you have an intent to exceed. Last year we passed this local law and I was able to with working with everyone bring the budget under the cap. That's certainly our intention again this year. We are close with our budget, not quite there yet, but we will get there. As a precaution because in the event that there's a miscalculation either by what is considered to be under or exempted from the cap we just want to make sure that we are covered in case something goes wrong. It's certainly our intent to be under the cap. I will open this for public discussion if anyone has any comments.
