**LEGAL NOTICE:** The Clerk read the legal notice, which was duly published in the Warwick Valley Dispatch on October 31, 2012.

Supervisor Sweeton – This is for the special districts and for public information special districts charges are only paid by those benefiting from those special districts. We now have two sewer districts, the main sewer district which serves Wickham Village, Wickham Knolls, Kings Estates, Ridge Homes and formally the Mid Orange Correctional Facility and we also have the Fairgrounds Sewer District which is comprised of only two parcels at this point to serve the Fairgrounds commercial complex. There are three users, Chase Bank, Auto Zone and Price Chopper and we have our water districts with Wickham being the largest, Bellvale, Eurich Heights, West Side Water in Greenwood Lake and the Fairgrounds Water District and the Pine Island Water District. Fairgrounds again serves only that complex and the other districts are fairly small with Greenwood Lakes being the second largest comprised of a year round system and a summer system which only operates seasonally. The other districts would be the recycling district which includes the Town and the Village of Warwick but excludes the Village of Florida and Greenwood Lake. All of our special districts have not increased significantly in the budget for this year. I will open it up for comment on the special districts.

There were no public comments for or against this public hearing.
