The goal of this mitigation planning effort is to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property from natural hazard events. Mitigation is not how we respond to natural disasters like floods and wildfires, but rather how we as a community can lessen or prevent the impact of such things in the first place. The mitigation planning process involves identifying and profiling the natural hazards most likely to occur in a community, assessing vulnerability to these hazards, and establishing goals, actions, and projects that mitigate the associated risks. The development of this mitigation plan will also ensure continued eligibility on the part of the county and communities for non-emergency, federal hazard mitigation grants.

As a prominent agency in our county, you or a representative are invited to attend the upcoming planning team meetings as a representative of the community at large. Public input on the mitigation process is important and residents are encouraged to educate themselves about the planning process and offer input. The planning team anticipates having a plan draft by June 2013, at which time the public will be provided the opportunity to review the plan and comment.



FIRST: AUTHORIZING said Town to acquire open spaces and areas pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 247 from Bollenbach Farms, LLC and Mary V. Bollenbach and John D. Bollenbach.; STATING the estimated maximum cost thereof, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, is \$1,962,000.00; APPROPRIATING said amount therefore; and STATING the plan of financing includes payment of \$582,000.00 from current funds and the issuance of \$1,380,000.00 bonds of the Town to finance the balance of said appropriation, and the levy of a tax upon all the taxable real property within the Town to pay the principal of said bonds and interest thereon;

SECOND: AUTHORIZING the issuance of \$1,380,000.00 bonds of the Town pursuant to the Local Finance Law of the State of New York (the "Law") to finance said appropriation;

THIRD: DETERMINING and STATING the period of probable usefulness applicable to the purpose for which said bonds are authorized to be issued is thirty (30) years; the proceeds of said bonds and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation thereof may be applied to reimburse the Town for expenditures made after the effective date of this bond resolution for the purpose for which said bonds are authorized; the proposed maturity of said bonds will exceed five (5) years;


