

Lead Removal Assistance Available for Orange County Property Owners

The Lead Hazard Reduction Program's goal is to make interior and exterior housing surfaces lead safe.



Lead comes from lead-based paint on walls, cabinets, porches, and fire escapes. Lead can be present in soil contaminated with old leaded gasoline or paint, and water from lead soldered pipes.



To help make Orange County residences safer places call or email to see if you qualify for our program.



Homeowners and landlords of pre-1978 houses or apartments may be eligible for lead hazard control work. Homeowners must meet modest household income guidelines (currently \$63,900 for a family of four). Landlords properties qualify based on tenant income, not landlords income.

Lead hazard control work may include replacement, removal, or enclosure of lead-based painted components, stabilization of lead-based painted surfaces, friction surface treatments, and mitigation of lead contaminated soil.
