TOWN OF WARWICK
INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW
AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WARWICK

A Local Law amending Chapter 106 of the Code of the Town of Warwick in relation to leaving boats unattended or stored at Wickham Woodlands Park or Wickham Boat Launch at Simpson lane, as more fully set forth below:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Warwick, Orange County, New York, as follows:

Section 1 –TOWN CODE AMENDED:

The Town of Warwick Town Code is hereby amended by adding Section 106-10 G. to read as follows:

Section 106-10 G. Unattended or Stored Boats. Paragraph G. shall be added to read as follows:

G. Leaving boats unattended or stored at Wickham Woodlands Park or the Wickham Lake Boat launch at Simpson Lane is prohibited. Owners of such boats violating the provisions of this chapter are subject to the immediate removal of such boats, without notice, by the Town, the cost of storage of such boat(s) by the Town, and the penalties provided in Section 106-11.

The Town of Warwick Town Code is hereby further amended by adding Section 106-11 C. to read as follows:

Section 106-11 C. Storage Fees. Commencing on the effective date of this Article, the boat storage fees shall be \$15.00 per day.

Section 2. – This Local Law will take effect upon the filing of same with the New York State Secretary of State.

3.0 - NOTICE TO BIDDERS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the **Town of Warwick** is accepting BIDS to repair a wingwall on Jayne Street Bridge.

The existing wingwall for the Jayne Street Bridge is rotating away from the edge of roadway and bridge abutment and needs to be replaced. The Jayne street project will replace the existing wingwall with a precast gravity block wall system. Plans and Contract Documents may be reviewed or may be obtained from the **Office of the Town Clerk beginning July 5, 2018** upon payment of a non-refundable amount of \$50.00 per set.

ALL SEALED BIDS shall be received by the **Office of the Town Clerk until 11am on July 17, 2018**, at which time they will be opened and read aloud. Work would be expected to begin immediately upon acceptance of the shop drawings and continue uninterrupted until completion of construction as described in the drawing set.

Bids must be accompanied by a list of contractor's available equipment and labor force, references regarding work similar in scope, along with proof of insurance (Worker's Compensation and Liability Insurance).

The **Town of Warwick** reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any formality or technicality in any bids, or to make an award to other than the low bidder. The Town also reserves the right to award all or any part of the work, or to cancel the entire project. Bids shall be awarded in accordance with General Municipal Law §103.
