

## FARE DETAILS AND GUIDELINES

**FARES FOR ALL BUS SERVICES: One  
Way/ per person/ per stop**

**Regular Fare** \$2.00

Children 4 and under free with adult fare

**Half Fare /Seniors 60+** \$1.00

**Half Fare/ Disabled** \$1.00

half fare verification may be required

You must be 12 years or older to ride without a guardian but Transit Supervisor has discretion.

Each time you get on the bus, you are required to pay a fare. You must pay as you board the bus and have exact change. You must pay your fare in order to ride the bus, no exceptions! In order to provide efficient service, we ask for 24 hours notice for all cancellations. Emergency cancels must be received in our office by 7:30 am. You may be charged the fare if less than 24 hours notice is given. Please ask about our policy on No-Shows and Late cancellations.

We are a "Curb to Curb" service. This means our buses are not permitted in driveways and we will pick up and drop off at the closest curb possible. We are not permitted on private roads or roads that are unsafe to travel. Drivers are NOT permitted to assist once off of the bus. The rider must be able to get to/ from the bus without assistance or you may have an assistant go with you.

## SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS

Warwick Transit services the entire Town of Warwick including the Villages of Warwick and Florida, Pine Island and Greenwood Lake. Our most popular destinations are Shoprite, Price Chopper, St. Anthony's Hospital, CVS, Main St. in the Village of Warwick and Florida, many Doctors offices and the Senior Center in Warwick. The Dial A Bus requires reservations which can be made by calling our office Monday–Friday 9:00am– 1:00pm.

### **DIAL -A- BUS**

The Dial A Bus runs Monday– Friday from 8:00am– 5:30pm. The Dial A Bus is a reservation service that will pick you up at your curb at a desired time that you set up when you call. When making your reservation, keep in mind that we will pick up other people along the way and to leave yourself enough travel time for appointments. You must be ready at least 5 minutes prior to your scheduled pick up time.

*ADA Compliant– If you need a bus with a wheelchair lift, please tell us when you call.*

### **LOCAL VILLAGE SERVICE**

The Local Bus is a shuttle route bus that runs on a set schedule in the Village of Warwick and Shoprite. Reservations are NOT required. Just be in a safe place along the route and flag down the driver. For a copy of the schedules, please see our website, ask a driver, or call the office. The bus runs 7 days a week. Saturday/ Sunday schedules are different than weekday schedules.

### **MIDDLETOWN SERVICE**

Warwick Transit provides transportation to Middletown every day Tuesday– Saturday. The bus goes to Middletown in the morning, stays up in Middletown to move you around to the different shopping centers, and then will leave Middletown around 2:00pm. The bus goes to the following:

- ORANGE PLAZA (Top and Bottom levels)
- DUNNING FARMS
- GALLERIA– (main entrance between Macy's and JC Penney's upper level)
- CRYSTAL RUN MEDICAL COMPLEX (#75,95,110, 155 upon request)
- ORANGE REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER (Upon Request)
- **Connect to Wallkill Shuttle to get to City of Middletown from Kohl Bus Stop**

### **MONROE SERVICE**

Warwick Transit provides transportation to Monroe every Friday. The Monroe bus gives you two options to go in the morning and two options to return in the afternoon. Please call for information. Bus stops at Wal-Mart, Target, Best Buy/ Home Goods, Kohls/ Michael's and the Woodbury Commons. Additionally, we stop at Shoprite, Stop and Shop, 505 Rt. 208 Medical Complex, 745 Rt. 17M (M+T Bank building) and many other doctors and stores. Please call if there is a different location you need to go. Reservations required. See back for details.

### **GOSHEN SERVICE**

Our bus goes to Hatfield Lane and Matthew St in Goshen with the Middletown bus each morning. We also pick up anyone who is at those locations who wants to go to Middletown. Call for details and information on when to make appointment. We offer other times to Hatfield Ln. on designated days/ times.
