## R2004-155 USE OF TOWN MUNICIPAL CHANNEL - BY OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS ,

Motion Councilman Gerstner, seconded Councilman Shuback to establish the following policy for use of the Town's Community TV Channel by various organizations:

- 1. The use of the Town's Community TV Channel by organizations for posting of the organization's notices, meeting dates, activity dates and the like, shall be permitted provided the organization applying for such use is a bona fide New York State Not-for-Profit Corporation or an organization recognized as a tax exempt organization and under Section 501C of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 2. Use of the channel by any other type of organization may be approved on an ad hoc basis by the Town Board provided the use, in the sole discretion of the Town Board, is in the general public interest, is not defamatory, is not of a political, individual or adversarial nature in any way.
- 3. Application for use of the channel shall be on a form approved by the Town and shall contain the proposed text of any desired notice to be displayed on the Channel. For generic recurring notices such as regular monthly meeting dates, etc., the application need only be submitted once, provided that it is clear from the application that approval for recurring notices is requested. All applications (whether by organizations covered by paragraphs 1 and 2 above) shall be voted upon by the Town Board for approval of content.
