COUNCILMAN DE ANGELO REPORT

1. The Warwick Valley Humane Society is experiencing multiple emergency housing calls for pets of owners who have been hospitalized and/or suddenly homeless and have no other pet care resources. Currently they have 4 dogs and 1 cat from those situations.
2. They are in serious need of bleach, paper towels, paper plated, heavy duty garbage bags, Merrick or Natural Balance canned dog food, Pate style canned cat or kitten food, medium size exam gloves and monetary donations to help with veterinary costs.
3. They are currently seeking persons interested in helping care for the shelter pets. They are volunteer positions open 2 days a week from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. Tuesday and Saturday to answer phones and greet visitors. Please call the shelter at 845-986-2473 if interested.
4. They currently need 2 full time Animal Care and Control Employees which includes weekends and 2 nights availability for animal emergency calls. You must be 21 years of age with a clean drivers license and background. The position includes cleaning, feeding, medicating, socializing pets, picking up stray dogs, rescuing injured orphaned animals,

enforcing dog control ordinances, and conducting ongoing dog census, you must be able to lift 50 pounds, take initiative and work well with others. If you're interested, please call 45-986-2473. They are hiring immediately and they desperately need people.

5. Town of Warwick Friendly Visitor Program for the month of November the number Of neighbors helped was 30, the number of volunteers helping those neighbors was 26, the total number of services provided by volunteers was 234 and the number of hours provided by the volunteers was 145.

COUNCILMAN KOWAL REPORT

1. Samantha Walters, the Manager of Mountain Lake Park sent me her yearend report and it reads as follows. 1 Community Festival called the Full Moon Festival, 3 Boy Scout campouts and service days, 5 weddings by Warwick Residents, 6 plays in the theater, 14 community events including nature, science and park programs, 24 events that support community resources including the Warwick Police and Fire Departments, Scouts, Rotary, School District, Historical Society, Prevention Coalition, Community Non-profits and more, 40 pickleball players that participated in the clinics, 42 children who participated in the town swim lessons, 104 parties at the lodge, 118 fishing and boating licenses, 121 children who regularly attended the Mountain Lake Park pre-school and after school clubs, 144 senior pool passes, 203 family pool passes, 211 people who stayed over night in the cabins and apartments, 716 hours cooking in the kitchen and 822 volunteer hours by people of the community. We are looking forward to a very robust year next year because a lot of these things that occurred happened while the park was being renovated and things were not available for the full year. I have been told by good sources that the total revenue for the park this year was \$156,000. We don't look to make a profit on our town parks, but there are things there that are generating revenue that will go towards renovations and support other programs that we do. Thank you, Samantha, for running that for us.

COUNCILMAN GERSTNER REPORT

1. The DPW has been busy rebuilding a catch basin on Cedar Hill Drive, clean trench drain on Kain Road, cleaning ditches for Cascade Road, West Ridge Road and Continental Road, tree work townwide, filling potholes townwide, sanded mountain routes on December 11th, doing vehicle maintenance as needed, making emergency repairs as needed, replacing road signs as needed and hauling road grit to stockpile.

2. Also, Mother Nature has been kind to us, we haven't had too much expenses with snow removal.
