

Dear Municipalities and Solid Waste Haulers:

We are writing to advise that effective April 1, 2023, tipping rates at all Orange County Transfer Stations will be as follows:

- Single Stream Recycling (SSR) \$120.00 per ton (2022 rate \$110/ton). This rate reflects the results of the Haul and Processing bids received for SSR.
- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) \$128.25 per ton (2022 rate \$121.25/ton). This rate reflects an increase in the bid price for Haul and Dispose of our MSW.

We typically endeavor to provide rate changes in the Fall to allow for budgets to be adjusted. However, in this case that was not possible as increases to contractual expenses and changes to the recycling market required solicitation of new bids at the end of the year.

CONDITIONALLY EXEMPT SMALL QUANTITY GENERATOR CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify that I am a generator of hazardous waste within the State of New York and that because of the small volume of hazardous waste generated and/or stored, I qualify for conditionally exempt small quantity generator status.

I understand that in order for conditionally exempt small quantity generator status, I must meet <u>all three</u> of the following conditions:

- 1. Generate less than 1 kg/month (2.2 pounds) of acute hazardous waste (as defined by 6 NYCRR Part 371), and never store more than this amount on site at any time; and
- 2. Generate less than 100 kg/month (220 pounds) of all other hazardous waste (as defined by 6 NYCRR Part 371), and never store more than 1000 kg/month on site at any time.
- 3. Transport a maximum of 220 lbs of hazardous waste at one time.

Only if I am a farmer, I realize that I may store up to 1000 kg. (2200 pounds) of non-acute hazardous waste pesticides on my farm without losing my conditionally exempt status, provided that these wastes are brought to a household hazardous waste collection program.

I further understand that if, in the future, I exceed the quantity limitations described above, I will become subject to additionally regulation as a hazardous waste generator and will no longer be eligible to participate in this type of collection program.

I certify that I have the authority to make these statements on behalf of my farm or business. Also, I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that the items brought for collection came from my farm or business located in Orange County.

IRREVOCABLE OFFER OF DEDICATION WARWICK ISLE BOULEVARD

THIS AGREEMENT made the ____day of _____, 2023, by and between

Warwick Isle Group LLC, a New York Limited Liability Company, with offices located at 1136 Kings Highway, Suite 5, Chester, New York 10918 (hereinafter called "Subdivider") and the Town of Warwick, a municipal corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, with offices at 132 Kings Highway, Warwick, New York 10990 (hereinafter called "Town").

WITNESSETH

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of TEN and NO/I 00 (\$10.00) DOLLARS and other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid by the Town and in furtherance of performance of the conditions of Final Approval of Section 1 for seven (7) lots including one (1) Affordable Home granted April 6, 2011 established by the Town for the land development plan of the Subdivider to be filed in the Office of the Town Clerk and Orange County, entitled Warwick Isle Cluster Subdivision "Section1" dated September 19, 2004, as revised and prepared by Kirk Rother, P.E. (the Plat) the Subdivider hereby irrevocably offers to the Town, its successors and assigns, the dedication of the premises more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof together with an easement over Lots 4 and 5 and over the Open Space Area C-1 for purposes of a temporary cul de sac facilitating ingress and egress to the lots from the public highway. The Subdivider hereby delivers to the Town proper conveyances in statutory form for recording, so as to convey in fee simple the land and/or interest in land, together with any improvements, described in Schedule "A" to the Town together with an easement over Lots 4 and 5 for purposes of a temporary cul de sac facilitating ingress and egress to the lots from the public highway., said instruments to be held by the Town until such time as the Town may decide to accept this irrevocable offer.

The Subdivider hereby waives any claim for damages in the event the Town shall lay out, by condemnation or otherwise, any street or highway over the lands hereby offered for highway purposes. The Subdivider warrants that it is seized of said premises in fee simple and has good and unencumbered right to convey the same except for existing rights of public utility companies, and in proof thereof; the Subdivider agrees to furnish, at its expense, such searches of title or policy and surveys as reasonably may be required by the Town, or a successor municipality.

The Subdivider covenants that it will comply with the general notes on the Plat and that it, its successors and/or assigns will maintain and remove snow and ice from all proposed roads and drainage structures within the aforesaid subdivision, until the same are accepted for dedication by the Town.

At the time of this offer to and such acceptance by the Town, the Subdivider covenants title to such land shall be good and marketable and free from all liens and encumbrances. The Subdivider covenants to pay all costs and expenses reasonably incurred by the Town to clear and accept title to the premises herein offered, including, without limitation, the costs and expenses of eminent domain proceedings, if necessary, and all real property taxes and/or assessments levied or due prior to the time the premises are placed on the exempt roll.

At such time as the proposed roadway becomes dedicated to the Town in future Sections, the temporary easements herein may be abandoned and the future developer of said through street shall reclaim lawn areas and install driveways connecting to the roadway for all affected lots.

The Subdivider agrees to obtain good and valid releases of all Subdividers, mortgagees, lienors and others required to consent to such dedications, at its expense, subject to approval by the Town's attorney.
