

COUNCILMAN DE ANGELO REPORT

- 1. The Post Report for December 2021 is as follows: Greenwood Lake had 104 calls, the Town outside the Village had 418 calls, Pine Island had 224 calls, the Village of Warwick had 434 calls and the Greenwood Lake Volunteer Ambulance District had 45 calls for a total of 1,225 for the month of December.
- 2. The Florida Union Free School District sent a letter to Police Chief McGovern thanking him and his team for their professionalism and support during an emergency situation.
- 3. The Warwick Valley Humane Society due to their temporary location they are only able to accept donations of needed supplies which are paper towels, canned Pate cat food, heavy duty garbage bags, ECO's laundry detergent and equine pine pellet bedding which you can get from Wadeson's or Tractor Supply.
- 4. Due to the recent surrender of horses and injured cats they are having a very critical shortage of funds in their Critical Care Fund and they need donations. Donations are greatly appreciated and may be sent to WVHS P.O. Box 61, Warwick, NY and mark it "Special Fund".
- 5. Current residents available for adoption are 5 dogs, 32 adult cats, 29 kittens, 2 male rabbits and 4 horses in foster care.
- 6. Suzyn Barron asked me to mention that outside animals need protection from the cold and wind. In New York State dogs must have an insulated dog house, be off the ground and large enough to lay comfortably with the surrounding are kept clean and unfrozen water available at all times. She's asking you to be humane and provide insulated housing if feeding outdoor cats and for any animals kept outdoors.
- 7. Town of Warwick Friendly Visitor Program for the month of December the number of neighbors helped was 35, the number of volunteers helping those neighbors was 29, the total number of services provided by volunteers was 397 and the number of volunteer hours provided for the year were 4,726. They are in serious need of volunteers and they are having 4 volunteer training programs. There will be one on February 9th at 5:30 p.m., February 24th at 10:00 a.m. March 9th at 5:30 p.m. and March 24th at 10:00 a.m. If you need help or you want to volunteer if you need a ride for shopping or a doctor's office you can call 845-986-1124 ext. 400, and leave a message.

We have a fairly smooth process; I want to thank the Warwick Police Department and the Department of Public Works for making that run so smoothly. We tentatively scheduled another one for this Sunday from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. at the same place at the Prison. You will be directed by the Police to enter the exit road of the park and circle around the park and come out the entrance of the park where you will be handed 2 kits per car. It goes very smoothly and I encourage people not to come hours in advance, it goes really well and it's a great spot to do it. It will be while supplies last and we think we will get 2,000 kits from the County but we won't know until tomorrow. I have also through the County secured kits for the three villages and they will have their own distribution at a time that they will announce. We've been in communication with St. Anthony's Community Hospital while everyone is tired there, they are not at capacity and they are managing very well and they are a tremendous asset to our community, we're glad to have them here.
- 2. Community Preservation Fund receipts for December were \$179,244.76 a very robust amount and reflected by the fact that the housing market is very hot all over, but especially here in the Town of Warwick.
- 3. I did go over all of the journal entries that the Comptroller made and they were all in order and I did sign off on those.
- 4. Supervisors Corner is published each week in the Warwick Dispatch, with excerpts printed in the Warwick Advertiser.

- the Town Board has determined that the property is not needed for any Town purpose; and
- b. the Town Board has determined to sell the property for adequate consideration of no less than fair market value; and
- c. the Town Board has determined that the fair market value of the parcel intended to be conveyed to the purchaser is no more than \$5,000.00; and

A lot of them came in over the weekend this past week.

Gail Buckland - At the last meeting you just said there is no need for an official Town Newspaper.

Supervisor Sweeton - I said the Town is not required to have an official paper. That's what I said, correct.

Gail Buckland - Just one other question. The Newspaper of Record is different from the official Town Newspaper. Is that correct?

Supervisor Sweeton - I'm not sure that's why I'm not going to answer that tonight. I'll try to get that information. As defined under 3 Sections of New York State Law, different sections of the New York State law, they define an official newspaper. I don't know what paper of record is but I'll look into that for you, for sure. Anyone else?

Seeing no other comments, any Board Members have any last-minute comments? Again Kevin, welcome, looking forward to working with you.
