ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTANTS REPORT

COUNCILMAN DE ANGELO REPORT

1. The Post Report for May 2022 is as follows: Greenwood Lake had 151 calls, the Town outside the Village had 599 calls, Pine Island had 312 calls, the Village of Warwick had 539 calls and the Greenwood Lake Volunteer Ambulance District had 62 calls for a total of 1,663 for the month of May.

Police Chief Rader – After a year of researching camaras and going out to bid we got training done today for most of the officers and we are going to start wearing the body camaras starting this shift now. We will work out the bugs in the next couple of weeks, but there's a camara for every officer and we will be recording all interactions with the public. I appreciate the Boards support on this venture from the beginning and I see nothing but good things moving forward.

Supervisor Sweeton – This was an issue raised in the executive order 203 discussions that we had and at that time we felt we didn't have the resources to move forward, but after Chief Rader did some research after we talked to some experts it seemed to make sense to us and after much discussion, we committed to fund it. I comment Chief Rader because he did seek different vendors, manufacturers, researched organizations, using different ones and we did get a cost-effective vendor for this. I think it's going to be good, good for the officers, good for the community and we're looking for to rolling it out.

- 2. The Warwick Valley Humane Society is giving us a warning about the impending fireworks from the Warwick Fire Department's Carnival this weekend and the 4th of July next weekend, please keep your pets and farm animals safe and secure.
- 3. This month the Warwick Valley Humane Society has had to house in addition to dogs and cats, a stray parakeet, a stray sulcate tortoise and two abandoned rabbits.
- 4. The trusses on the new shelter facility have arrived and are being installed this week.

Construction is moving along but we still haven't reached their goal to finish this project. Donations toward the building fund can be sent to P.O. Box 61, Warwick.

- 5. Their current population is 7 dogs, 37 cats, 21 kittens, 4 rabbits, 2 horses and the tortoise.
- 6. The Town of Warwick Friendly Visitor Program for the month of March the number of neighbors helped was 29, the number of volunteers helping those neighbors was 31, the total number of services provided by volunteers was 290 and the number of volunteer hours provided were 164. There are 184 neighbors in the program and 76 volunteers. They need more volunteers. They are having training on Thursday, July 12th at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, July 28th at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, August 9, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. and Thursday, August 25, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. If you would like to volunteer, please call 845-986-1124 ext. 400.

Stephen Urbanski - Can I make a suggestion?

Supervisor Sweeton - Yes sir.

Stephen Urbanski – You know the pavilion where the legion has all of their outdoor functions, they have the band set up all the way to the back and that band is enclosed.

Supervisor Sweeton - Right.

Stephen Urbanski – It faces my house.

Supervisor Sweeton - Ok.

Stephen Urbanski – They set up the band and speakers there. I would like to have somebody give a little consideration and take a look at that place and have the speakers redirected so the noise isn't coming at my house.

Supervisor Sweeton – You're right on the corner where the road bends?

Stephen Urbanski – No, the second house. It's been an ongoing issue and that night when we had the problem, I had guests at the house. They were staying in the back bedroom and they left early because they were upset with the noise. What's the DB rating for the Town of Warwick for outdoor functions?

Supervisor Sweeton – It runs between 65-70 at the property line, so I would have to look where the legion property ends and yours begins.

Stephen Urbanski – At the property line if it's 60 because even if it's over where the band is set up that's an open area.

Supervisor Sweeton – And at night sound travels I get it.

Stephen Urbanski – The sounds travels and then they increase plus they have the strobe lighting, I mean it was unreal. They light up my garage and my whole house and the dogs went crazy. It was unreal and as far as I'm concerned nobody monitors that at the legion. You talk to them and they tell you that they do and I was told the bartender is the one that makes the contracts out and monitors it. How can you monitor anything if you're over there behind the bar serving drinks and stuff like that?

Caroline Urbanski – This isn't the first time with the lights either and the lights are unbelievable. You go outside they blind you; I was trying to walk the dogs and the one dog was going crazy and the whole place was purple, green, white.

Supervisor Sweeton – Was it a wedding or something?

Stephen Urbanski – It was a wedding, but his is not the first time this has happened. A couple of times I've never made an issue of it, but this last time it was unreal. Plus, the fact my wife has lupus and she doesn't need the aggravation, she has enough dealing with lupus. I would be happy if the Town Board would consider reevaluating the situation down there for the hours the functions are going especially for weddings and things like that, maybe set it back an hour.

Supervisor Sweeton – I'll check with the Building Department tomorrow and see what they've done and I think you had your contact information on your letter, so I'll either give you a call or I'll stop by.

Stephen Urbanski – Who was the Officer on duty that night on June 4th?

Supervisor Sweeton - We'll look it up I don't know, but we'll look that up.

Stephen Urbanski – because I got that call and as far as I'm concerned nothing was done. The Officer tells me that it's a party and basically there's nothing they can do and he didn't do a thing.

Supervisor Sweeton – Well the Chief and I will talk and we will find out who it was and what response we get.

Stephen and Caroline Urbanski – Thank you very much.
