Supervisor Sweeton – The proposals for the engineering firm for the large scale solar, we solicited three proposals and we only received once response and that was from Barton & Loguidice, just so the Board knows that.

SUPERVISORS REPORT

1. Coronavirus update, the Town Hall is fully functioning and really all of our

services with the exception of the Dial-A-Bus and Court were functioning throughout the whole pandemic. We had some limited access issues but we were still able to maintain essential services. Our Police Department was fully staffed, our DPW was working, the Building Department was functioning, all of the offices and we came through that really well. Now the building is back open, masks are required to come in, we have hand sanitizer stations here, there are some protective stuff for the employees, so again we feel we are taking care of our employees yet still continue to do what we need to do. Dial-A-Bus is essentially back almost at full speed, it's being rolled out a little bit more as there were more passengers, clearly seniors have been heeding everybody's warning. They are the most vulnerable and they have not used the system so much, but they are starting to now and we are sanitizing them. We are sanitizing all of our parks daily, so our playground equipment and bathrooms are done daily, our beach is limited to Town Residents only and it has been very busy. The Town Residents have responded to going to the beach, which is great and we've been blessed with a lot of great parks and open space that has allowed our residents to enjoy themselves during this whole thing.

- 2. The Community Preservation Fund receipts for the month of June were \$56,064.34 and the total in the fund is \$3,584,007.10 and we are still working but getting close now to closing the Newport Bloom II Farm, which will be a good acquisition.
- 3. Disappointment, but we are canceling the Senior Citizen BBQ that's normally held in August. There is no way to socially distance the 700 Seniors that come to that event and it's really just not worth risking them for the BBQ, so we promised we will do it bigger and better next year and we hope that they stay safe.
- 4. Town Beach has been good and I was able to secure and the Board approved the purchase of two accessible beach chairs at the beach, so a handicapped individual that goes to the beach now has the ability to safely get into the water. We are very glad that we were able to do that.
- 5. Pine Island Park improvements, I did want to mention that I received a notice that an Eagle Scout Luke Bloominberg has completed his project and it's a gaga pit and we didn't know what that was initially, but it's a cool game and it has been built out there. I want to thank Luke for the great job, I've seen pictures of it and I can't wait to go out this weekend and take a look at it. We did refurbish the bathrooms in Pine Island this year and they are really, really great and we did that in house, so Ben thank you to your staff for that.
- 6. I received a letter from the New York State DOT today with good news. They were writing to inform the Town of Warwick that the New York State Department of Transportation plans to resurface a small section of Route 17A from Horse Hill Lane which is where they stopped a year ago to VanDuzer Place in the Town of Warwick. VanDuzer Place is actually in the Village of Warwick, so they continue to do a little bit at a time repave 17A, so maybe by next year they will get through the Village.
 - 7. Journal entries were made with the Comptroller and they were all in order.

They do seem to have the room to do it and we will monitor it; it is a one year permit and if it becomes a problem we may have to address that to our zoning.
