#### PRESENTATION:

#### DR. RICHARD HULL TOWN HISTORIAN

The big plaque outside the door with all those names of people who served in the Revolutionary War and many under General Hathorn's Fourth Orange County Regiment is going to get larger, it's going to grow. We are going to have another plaque alongside it because and thanks to Deborah Sweeton. Deborah has been for 6 years now doing research trying to identify people who were associated with General Hathorn Regiment during the Revolutionary War. She's been traveling all over the place to Albany, to Goshen, here, to Washington, wherever and looking at documents, looking at testimonies that were given by people from our area who fought in the Revolutionary War. These testimonies were given by them or their widows because most of the pensions were not paid out until 1832. These people had to come forward and provide documentation or testimony and brought in witnesses who claimed they fought along side of them in the battle. She exhaustedly and meticulously found many, many people who we did not know of. She discovered that they were participants and to win a pension they had to prove it and they had to talk about how they got involved and so forth. What Deborah has done is she has come forward with hundreds of names that we can add to our list. It's more than just names though, these are human beings, these are people and through these testimonies we learn about that. It has opened up a whole new window on our knowledge of and understanding of the American Revolution as it pertained to us here and that's a tremendous service. There are very few people who have really done that kind of research and the original documents. These are primary sources and as a scholar myself as a historian that requires a lot of work, a lot of work. I know Deborah for at least 6 years and maybe 7 now has been involved in this project, but it's more than just that. Now it's taking here into the minutes of the general court sessions in Goshen going back to 1727 and moving forward to 1779 and that too is providing us with a tremendous amount of information and that is so valuable. There are very few communities that have someone like Deborah and our Deputy Historian Sue to get into original resources. Sue Gardner has written an outstanding book on this area during the Revolutionary War. This is an

enormous contribution and I felt that Deborah needed recognition because very few people are aware that Deborah is famous for the beautification of Warwick with her efforts with the organization Warwick in Bloom, they were able to not only win a national award, but an international award as well, international recognition as well for what they were doing to our beautification in our community. That was an extraordinaire accomplishment and undertaking for her. I really felt that she needed to be recognized for the work that she's done in looking at one of our most important periods in history and also looking at Veterans. We are all very concerned about Veterans today and we've been honoring them and most recently Michaels been working at the Land Mark Inn last week waiting on tables as a one-night waiter to raise money for our living Veterans. We need to go back into history and we have to continue to honor Veterans of all of our conflicts that preserve our independence. Deborah and Sue have been working very, very hard on this and partly through Friends of General Hathorn and he really was one of the most distinguished and outstanding residents we've ever had in Warwick's history, so I felt the time has come for Deborah to be honored and recognized and thanked by everyone who is here, and by everyone in the community and the entire County for this service. It's wonderful to know that she hasn't stopped now, this has led to more projects which is fantastic. Sue our Deputy Historian and Deborah have been working together now for 6 years on these projects and it's just a wonderful team.

Sue Gardner – Deputy Town Historian – Basically what Deborah has done is, she's taken the bones and she's put the flesh on them and they becoming alive. History isn't alive unless you can see how it relates to you. The documents which are hand written in 18<sup>th</sup> century script, hundreds and hundreds of pages she's finding their story. I saw Andre, I was there in the battle of London, I was at the Boston Tea Party and these are all Warwick persons we are talking about. When we go into the schools and we can say to the kids, that house there where you're studying in your textbook that guy lived right here. She basically saved the project; it was very daunting and she appeared one day and went down the rabbit hole to search with me and she's further down than me and I'm not sure she's going to come. It's wonderful to see that Warwick is the revolution and by the time we end with the children they start out with the revolution, Boston and by the time we finish where is the revolution, here. That's what we are doing with this project and I can't thank you enough Deborah because I would have just thrown up my arms and ran off, thank you very much.

Dr. Richard Hull – Town Historian – Thanks Sue. This is a certificate of recognition and appreciation and it reads this way. "Deborah Sweeton the people of Warwick wish to express their deep appreciation for your outstanding efforts to preserve and deepen our knowledge and our understanding of local founding Veterans of the Revolutionary War, particularly General Hathorn's Fourth Orange County Regiment." During your research you also discovered many other Warwick men who served with the Continental Army or other units. Your exhausted and path breaking research in official records extending from 1727 to 1779. You've given us fresh and valuable insights into Veterans and their experiences.

Supervisor Sweeton – Thank you Dr. Hull and I will say Sue hit the nail on the head to bring the history to life, it's going to hook the young people with the vast amount of history that we have here and we thank you for that.

Dr. Richard Hull – Town Historian – I should also mention that we knew Deborah first and foremost for all of your work now and for the beautification of our community and this was through the organization Warwick in Bloom and that led to international recognition. It was an amazing competition and we won it and we were up against organizations all over the world.

Deborah Sweeton - That was a joint effort, that wasn't just me.

Dr. Richard Hull – Town Historian – You had a very important part in it and their daughter was named Citizen of the Year in her community in Maine.

Deborah Sweeton - The same year her father was. This is all Sues fault. The reason why I got involved with Sue is because I'm very involved with genealogy. I appreciate the fact that after all of these years of doing it people all over the world took the time to either transcribe documents or photo copy them and put them online, so people like me can look at a document from France or Cornwall and I can prove that person is related to me. I was appreciative of that and I thought when I retire maybe I can do that for Warwick. the only person I knew to talk to about it was this person named Sue Gardner, who I did not know. I went into the library and Michael might have said to her that Deborah wants to talk to you. I went to meet her and I told her that's what I was interested in volunteering to do. She said we have a lot of records that are already online from the Town of Warwick. She said would you be interested in doing some other work, I said sure and that's how this American General Hathorn got started. I have read a lot about the revolution and started to put flesh on the bones. I never knew a lot about the revolution and I am a fanatic about it now and the stories are amazing. We had no idea what these people went through and I'm not talking about just the soldiers I'm talking about everybody, so it's been fascinating and I love it.

Supervisor Sweeton – Thank you and thank you Dr. Hull and thank you Sue Gardner for your service to the town, we appreciate that.

We will be posting fliers around both the Village of Warwick and the general Town of Warwick. The Village of Florida and Greenwood Lake do their own. I'm encouraging residents while we will be bringing our old database over to please go on and sign up anyway, because most of our old system is relying on a phone message and this one allows you to put in a mobile number to get a text or an e-mail address. You can also pick up a form from the Town Clerks office Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. or go onto the towns website or you can text Warwickalert to 99411and again we'll have some fliers put out so people can understand that.
