**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on Thursday, the 24th day of September, 2020, at 7:30pm, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, there will be a Public Hearing conducted by Town of Goshen Town Board, Town Hall, 41 Webster Avenue, Goshen, New York 10924, to consider Introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2020. The purpose of Introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2020 is to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Goshen and to maintain the *status quo* as to certain land uses related to energy storage facilities, as the present zoning regulations in the Town do not adequately address these types of uses.

The public hearing will be held in the Boardroom of Town Hall, unless the Governor's Executive Order 202.1 barring in-person attendance is extended; in which case, this Public Hearing shall be held via Zoom and a transcript shall be provided at a later date. ### TOWN OF GOSHEN INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW No. 2 OF 2020

### A LOCAL LAW ADOPTING A MORATORIUM ON ENERGY STORAGE FACILITIES

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Goshen, Orange County, New York as follows:

### SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT.

The purpose of this Local Law is to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Goshen and to maintain the *status quo* as to certain land uses related to energy storage facilities, as the present zoning regulations in the Town do not adequately address these types of uses. The moratorium will stop the processing of applications for, and the issuance of any permits, certificates of occupancy and approvals for energy storage facilities. The moratorium is for a period of six (6) months, allowing the Town Board to analyze and determine potential appropriate revisions and amendments to the Town of Goshen Zoning Code concerning this use.

#### SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS.

The Town of Goshen Town Board does hereby find that without a temporary halt on the processing, permitting, and approvals for energy storage facilities, there is the potential that such uses could be located in unsuitable areas within the Town and/or on particular lots without adequate dimensional regulations in place. The potential for the unsuitable location of, and lack of proper dimensional regulations for, such uses would have materially adverse and irreversible impacts on the Town.

The Town Board also finds that it is in need of time to perform the necessary analysis of the potential types of energy storage facilities, that could be located in the Town. By maintaining the *status quo* regarding such uses the Town Board can provide for the planned orderly growth and development of the Town.

### SECTION 3: MORATORIUM IMPOSED; APPLICABILITY

For a period of time of six (6) months following the effective date of the adoption of this Local Law no application may be processed, and no permits, certificates of occupancy, approvals, denials, determinations or interpretations may be issued or granted for energy storage facilities.

The term "energy storage facilities" shall be broadly construed to include any facility designed to store electric power to be marketed, sold or used for other than the power demands of the improvements on the property on which such facility is located, including discrete, stand-alone facilities, and facilities that are more than a small, incidental component of a land use application as determined by the reviewing board or official. Not included within the scope of this moratorium are energy storage facilities designed to store electric power solely for the use of the improvements located on the same property.

This Local Law shall be binding on the Town Board, Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, Building Inspector, all Town officials and employees, and any applicant or real property

owner in the Town desiring to apply for or receive a permit, certificate of occupancy or approval in the Town of Goshen.

During the period of the moratorium, the Town Board shall endeavor to complete all reasonable and necessary review, study, analysis and, if warranted, revisions to the Town of Goshen Code. During the period of the moratorium, no applications will be accepted, nor permits, certificates of occupancy or approvals issued, which would authorize development within the Town for energy storage facilities, as described above.

#### SECTION 4: TERM

This moratorium shall be in effect for a period of six (6) consecutive months from its effective date.

This Local Law shall be subject to renewal for a cumulative period of up to an additional six (6) months, if necessary, by Resolution(s) of the Town Board.

### SECTION 5: EFFECT ON OTHER LAWS

To the extent that any law, ordinance, rule or regulation, or parts thereof, are in conflict with the provisions of this Local Law, including all provisions of Article 16 of the New York State Town Law concerning special use permit, site plan, building permit and certificate of occupancy procedure and requirements, this Local Law shall control and supersede such law ordinance, rule or regulation.

#### SECTION 6: WAIVER

Owing to the limited scope and duration of this moratorium, there is no provision being made in this Local Law for any waivers to its applicability. However, the Town Board may, but is not obligated to, promulgate regulations by a Resolution of the Board authorizing a hardship waiver process to this moratorium.

### SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the clause, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

#### SECTION 8: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with New York Municipal Home Rule Law.

# **O&R: ONE-TIME BILL CREDIT FOR 72-HOUR OR LONGER ISAIAS OUTAGES**

PEARL RIVER, NY Sept. 18, 2020 4 p.m. – Orange & Rockland (O&R) customers who lost power for three consecutive days (72 hours) or more due to Tropical Storm Isaias will receive a one-time credit, resulting in a reduction on bills issued between October and November 2020, the company announced today.

This one-time credit will offset fixed-monthly customer charges based on 30 days of service. Credit will be based on a pro-rata reduction in 30-day fixed charges based on customers' average outage duration. Additionally, lower energy consumption due to the outage also will result in reduced charges.

Residential customers will receive a \$2.60 to \$5.85 credit against the \$19.50 monthly customer charge depending on outage length, while small- and medium-size business customers will receive \$2.27 to \$8.17 against the \$21.00 monthly charge. Larger commercial customers will receive similar credits based on service classification.

The monthly delivery-charge reductions are in addition to company reimbursements announced on August 8 for food and prescription medicine spoilage for those enduring a two-day-or-more power loss because of Tropical Storm Isaias.

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (O&R), a wholly owned subsidiary of Consolidated Edison, Inc., one of the nation's largest investor-owned energy companies, is a regulated utility. Each candidate spent 15 to 20 minutes answering questions that ranged from policy and procedure, to integrity and decision making. All the candidates except P.O. Slesinski have a number of years of experience as uniformed patrol officers.

Two of the six stood out in my opinion and were recommended by every member of the panel. That is why I ask the Board to promote police officers Brian Luthin and John Harter to the supervisory rank of SGT at the meeting on September 24, 2020 - effective Saturday September 26, 2020, as it begins a full pay period.

I am sure these gentlemen will not disappoint the Board, the Department, or the community.

The Greenwood Lake Commission is officially notifying the residents and businesses around Greenwood Lake, as well as the public, that the 2020/2021 Lake drawdown is officially postponed until the fall of 2021/2022. This of course will be based on weather conditions and any other issues that could affect a decision to go forward with a drawdown at that time.

The Commission apologizes for the delay, as we have been waiting to hear from the NJDEP, only recently found out that it will be the Commission's decision to make. The NJDEP will not consider an action on its own without support of the Greenwood Lake Commission. After holding two public hearings, as well as additional discussions at three monthly Commission meetings, at which time, the Commissioners could not meet the required number of votes to continue or cancel the drawdown. This being the case, the drawdown is postponed until next year, pending scheduled public hearings to be held next January in New Jersey and February in New York.

The Commission was just informed, the NJDEP's evaluating the environmental benefits and impacts of conducting drawdowns across the state. The NJDEP is evaluating a wide range of factors regarding the impact of drawdowns, such as, water quality, from an ecological standpoint, HABS and other harmful bacteria/ toxins affecting water quality.

As the Commission receives more information regarding drawdowns, we will make that information known to everyone.
