

Training Outline

- New officers attend 880 hours of instruction at the police academy followed by 300-400 hours of supervised field training. (160 hours are State mandated for their final State certification)
- Sergeants receive 120 hours of instruction within one year of their promotion
- K9 officers receive 24-32 hours of continued training monthly
- All officers receive a minimum of 21 hours of in service training:
 - 12 hours of firearms
 - Use of Force Policy and mandatory NYS Penal Law review
 - 4 hours of Taser Training
 - 5 hours of CPR/AED and Narcan training
- Specialized training is offered as continued education for topics such as Car Seat technician
- All in service training is scheduled as the courses become available
- All officers successfully completed Principled Policing (Part 1 of 3 classes)
- All officers have been scheduled for Part 2- Implicit Bias training
