

TOWN OF WARWICK
ADOPTED LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 2022
AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WARWICK

A Local Law amending Chapter 127 of the Code of the Town of Warwick in relation to changing Section 127-5 to Reserved and replacing 127-6 with the new section 127-6, as more fully set forth below:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Warwick, Orange County, New York, as follows:

Section 1 -TOWN CODE AMENDED:

Section 127 of the Town of Warwick Town Code is hereby amended as follows:

§ 127-5 Reserved.

§ 127-6 Billing of charges; penalty for late payment; tax lien; final reading.

A.

All users shall be billed quarterly. Billings for any particular quarter shall be made within 20 days after the end of the billing. Payments are due within 20 days after the end of the period. Any payment not received within 30 days after the end of the billing shall be delinquent. The Town Supervisor is hereby authorized and designated to receive and collect all charges and other fees payable to the Town pursuant to this chapter.

B.

Unpaid sewer charges in arrears for 30 days after the billing due date shall be subject to a penalty of 4.5% of the amount due for 30 days or portion thereof of delinquency. When any bill is more than 90 days in default at year end closing, such bill shall be presented to the County of Orange for payment and said bill will then become part of the county tax lien on said property.

C.

Final sewer reading charge: \$40.
