MIKE DONOVAN – News Media, Orange & Rockland Utilities, and Inc. Memo received July 13, 2023 regarding a warning to customers about potential Gift Card Fraud. The typical scam scheme goes this way: Thieves posing as O&R employees call unsuspecting customers and threaten them with the immediate shut off of their electric service if they don't pay phony O&R bills with Green Dot or other prepaid debit cards. Here are two big reasons not to believe any thief who makes a shutoff threat:

NO DEBIT CARDS - O&R does not accept bill payment for electric and gas utility bills by Green Dot or any other prepaid debit cards. Never has.

• NO IMMEDIATE SHUTOFF - Disconnecting O&R electric or gas service for nonpayment of bills involves a multi-step process – including written communications from O&R to the customer over a period of several days, or even weeks – not hours. That process is regulated by the NYS Public Service Commission and NJ Board of Public Utilities. So, if someone calls you, says they are an O&R employee and threatens to shut off your electric or gas service that day if not immediately paid through a prepaid debit card, remember these tips:

- <u>Hang Up</u> Disengage so you're not further subjected to the thief's high-pressure "sales pitch."
- <u>Text Scam</u> After you hang up on them, the more aggressive thieves will try to repeat their shutoff threat by texting you. Ignore the threat. They are thieves.
- <u>Don't Hit "REDIAL"</u> The caller ID screen on your phone for the thief's call may read "Orange and Rockland Utilities," but that's a hi-tech bogus copy of the utility company's number. That's not O&R. Do not redial, and don't call the number that the caller gives you to call them back. That will reconnect you to the thief.
- <u>Fast Track</u> If you are unsure about whether you have an overdue balance on your O&R bill, the fastest way to find out is to log onto your account through <u>oru.com/myaccount</u> to review your latest account information. You also can call O&R's automated phone system at 1-877-434-4100. Have your Orange and Rockland account number ready and follow the automated phone prompts to check your balance.
- <u>Check the I.D.</u> If you are contacted by someone in-person or on the phone who says they represent O&R and you wish to verify their identity either ask for their photo ID card, if they are at the door, or get a call-back number if they are on the phone, and call O&R at: this new number 1-833-460-7059 during business hours Monday Friday 8 a.m. 4:30 p.m. or 1-877-434-
 - 4100 O&R's Customer Service Department off hours to verify their identity and the nature of their business with you. O&R employees and vendors are trained to cooperate with this request and are instructed to comply with a customer identity verification request.

Remember, if you are feeling threatened or otherwise uncomfortable about your security during the exchange, immediately report the incident to your local police department at 911.

1. The Post Report for July 2023 is as follows: Greenwood Lake had 127 calls, the Town outside the Village had 551 calls, Pine Island had 202 calls, the Village of Warwick had 457 calls and the Greenwood Lake Volunteer Ambulance District had 55 calls for a total of 1,392 for the month of June.

Police Chief Rader- I just wanted to remind the Board and the Public that we are having a fundraiser this Saturday for Officer Jordan Tetreault. She was recently injured badly in a motor vehicle accident. The 10-13 Event will be held at the Pine Island Fire House. The suggested donation is \$20.00 per person. There will be great food, beverages, raffles, corn hole and music by the Black Dirt Bandits.

SUPERVISORS REPORT

1. I want to point out that we published a notice of complete application as required by NYS to renew the SPDES permit for the surface discharge at the Mountain Lake Park. The Kutz camp had a SPDES permit years ago and never renewed it and then of course when a municipality takes over a property the DEC is a little more attentive. Therefore, we had to file a new SPDES request. The camps sewage is treated in a subsurface system. We are not approaching 22,000 gallons per day. Not at all. That is what the SPDES permit will be issued for. This is for the public's information. It has been published and you can send comments to the DEC if you so choose. Therefore, it is nothing new. It is just continuing it.

2. I want to point out that the Village of Greenwood Lake is celebrating its 100th year with a yearlong celebration and the first event is coming up on August 17th at 11am there is going to be a centennial float parade so that is kind of interesting. I think they have also resurrected

the bed race, which was a fixture in Greenwood Lake for many years. So perhaps the Town Board will enter a bed in the race. We will see. Anyway, let us support one of our Great Villages and their celebration!

3. Councilman Kowal alluded to the good feedback on the swim program this summer. Sam ran this program. I did go through them and everyone is just raving about how well it ran. Particularly your help (Sam) and Ben's help so congratulations. It was a success and a hit.
