

FARE DETAILS AND GUIDELINES

FARES FOR ALL BUS SERVICES: One Way/ per person/ per stop- cash only

RegularFare- General Public (5-54)

\$2.00 (4 and under are free with adult)

Seniors 55+ and Disabled-\$1.00

Reduced fare verification required

FARES MUST BE PAID EACH TIME YOU BOARD!

Sorry, No Fare- No Ride

You must be 13 years or older to ride without a guardian but Transit Supervisor has discretion.

Each time you get on the bus, you are required to pay a fare. You must pay as you board the bus and have exact change. You must pay your fare in order to ride the bus, no exceptions! In order to provide efficient service, we ask for 24 hours notice for all cancellations. Emergency cancellations must be received in our office by 7:00 am. Please ask about our policy on No-Shows and Late cancellations.

We are a "Curb to Curb" service. This means our buses are not permitted on drive- ways and we will pick up and drop off at the closest/ safest curb possible. We are not permitted on private roads or roads that are unsafe to travel. Drivers are NOT permitted to assist once off of the bus. The rider must be able to get to/ from the bus without assistance or you may have an assistant go with you.

SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS

Warwick Dial-A-Ride services the entire Town of Warwick including all Villages. Our most popular destinations are Shoprite, Price Chopper, St. Anthony's Hospital, CVS, Main St. in the Village of Warwick and Florida, many Doctors offices and the Senior Center in Warwick. The Dial A Ride requires reservations which can be made by calling our office Monday– Friday 8:00am– 2:00pm. Reservations can be made 1 day to 1 week in advance

DIAL -A- RIDE**

The Dial A Ride operates Monday– Friday from 8:00am–4:30pm and Saturday 8:30am- 3:30pm (Hours subject to seasonal changes) The Dial A Bus is a reservation service that will pick you up at your curb at a desired time that you set up when you call.

When making your reservation, keep in mind that we will pick up other people along the way and to leave yourself enough travel time for appointments. You must be ready at least 5 minutes prior to your scheduled pick-up time. Return trips must also be reserved if needed. Certain areas of Warwick may be restricted to certain times of day. Please call for information.

LOCAL VILLAGE SERVICE

The Local Village Bus is a shuttle route bus that runs on a set schedule around the Village of Warwick and up to Shoprite. Reservations are NOT required. Just be in a safe place along the route and flag down the driver. For a copy of the schedules, please see our website, ask a driver, or call the office. The bus runs 7 days a week. (Saturday/ Sunday schedules are different than weekday schedules.)

WALLKILL SERVICE**

We provide transportation to the Town of Wallkill every Wednesday, Thursday, Friday (earlier return) and Saturday. The bus goes to Wallkill in the morning, stays up in Wallkill to move you around to the different shopping centers, and then will leave Middletown around 2:00pm. (Friday 12:30pm return)

We reserve the right to cancel a run due to lack of ridership

MONROE SERVICE**

We provide transportation to Monroe/ Harriman 1st and 3rd Friday of each month. Please call for information/ time. Bus goes to Wal-Mart, Target, Best Buy/ Home Goods, Kohls/ Michael's and the Woodbury Commons. Additionally, we stop at Shoprite, Stop and Shop, 505 Rt. 208 Medical Complex, 745 Rt. 17M (M+T Bank building) and many other doctors and stores. You can connect to Monroe Dial A Ride. We may cancel a run due to lack of ridership.

GOSHEN SERVICE**

Our bus goes to Valley View, Social Services, Hatfield Lane, Matthews St Bus Stop, and the Government Center in Goshen. Please see driver or call for details on when we have this service. These are the only locations we drop off. You can Connect to Goshen Dial-A-Ride.

REQUIRED FOR ALL SERVICES EXCEPT THE LOCAL VILLAGE SERVICE
All reservations must be made through dispatch.
Cancellations only, may be left on our voice mail
